

A Fourth Line man has been charged with several offences in connection with the assault of a woman late Tuesday.

dent of Mercy International Canada. "Providing the money was the least we could do. Without this procedure, Marco had no hope."

The condition in Marco's blood vessel - known as a congenital malformation - had caused it to dilate much like an aneurism. Although a genetic condition, the problem became more acute for Marco recently when the vessel's growth began encroaching on his brain, stunting his development and causing seizures.

The procedure performed by doctors in Philadelphia effectively closed the vessel to stop the swelling.

Unequipped to treat Marco and overwhelmed by war casualties, doctors in Bosnia-Herzegovina turned early this fall to a doctor from Pennsylvania - Dr. Chris Chapman who was delivering relief supplies to the region. After discovering that only one hospital in Europe was equipped, but currently unable to perform the operation, Chapman

turned to The Children's Hospital of Philadelphia for assistance. The hospital agreed to help and a team of Pennsylvania doctors including a neurosurgeon, a neuroradiologist, and a cardiologist volunteered their

To cover the costs of the operation, Chapman turned to Mercy International Canada, a group which has been providing humanitarian assistance to the former Yugoslavia.

Doctors said today that Marco, who was flown to Philadelphia with his parents last week, should fully recover and return home by early
