Ford posts \$114-m third quarter loss

Ford Motor Company of Canada has recorded a \$114-million loss for the third quarter compared to a \$34-million loss for the same period one year ago.

On a year-to-date basis, Ford has lost \$86-million compared to a loss of \$213-million for the first nine months last year.

Company president James O'Connor said this week that sales in Canada, Australia and New Zealand reached a record \$11.8-billion or a 12 per cent increase over last year's sales for the first nine months.

In recording the quarterly loss, Ford set a \$3.6-billion sales record, up \$308-million over 1992 while the 186,500

units sold were up three per cent over last year.

Canadian Operations were adversely affected by the weakening of the Canadian dollar which increased the cost of U.S. purchases and higher product development costs including some of the 13 new products the company plans to introduce in the next two years.

Ford's car assembly plant is closed until the new year to convert the facility for production of the new front-wheel-drive Windstar minivan.

Canadian operations lost \$135-million in the quarter on \$2.9-billion sales compared with a \$54-million loss in the third quarter of 1992.
