MR. HENRY MOHNS Petawawa

Mrs.Lloyd Allan suggested that I meet with Mr. Henry Mohns. I called him and set up an

interview with him on July 21 1982.

When I went to see Mr. Mohns I introduced myself to him and explained to him what would

be done with the information.

I talked for a little while with Mr, Mohns and decided that I wouldn't turn on the tape

recorder because he does not speak that clearly. I continued talking with Mr. Mohns, I found out the

 $following\ information\ about\ Mr.\ Mohns.\ Mr.\ Mohns\ was\ born\ in\ Petawawa\ and\ has\ lived\ here\ all\ his\ life.$

He attended school at SS#1 Petawawa. When he was thirteen he went to work. He drove a team of horses

and skidded logs. He said that they drew logs from various areas around Petawawa.

He told me that he worked for the Munro Lumber Company. He worked six days a week for

\$30.00. For this company he was the cook for the lumber camp. He told me food was brought from North

Bay to the camp.

He was also a blacksmith for some time. He told me that he welded the o rods on the second

bridge in Petawawa. After his first year as a blacksmith he then worked for the Government, shoeing

horses and doing other jobs.

He told me that he was also a steam show attendant and that he built the first dance hall

in the Petawawa village.

I did enjoy meeting with Mr. Mohns however I was disappointed not being able to tape him.

Mr. Mohns memory did seem to be quite good however when I did ask him for any dates he couldn't remember

any dates.

Later Mr. Mohns got out a photo album and showed me quite a few pictures but unfortunately

they were quite recent pictures. I did ask him if he had any older pictures but he looked for them

and couldn't find any.
