Painted on the leather shield is the following:

Six Nations 1812 He rests in Peace 1912 Rodinosyonni

Brock was killed in action at the Battle of Queenston Heights in 1812. Haudenosaunee warriors from Grand River and Buffalo Creek fought against each other at that battle. The death of Brock had a big impact on the Grand River allies.



The 1912 shield shown on the first page has the image of bear standing over criss-crossed arrows. "He Rests in Peace" is the inscription in the middle. "Six Nations" is written across the top with some of the letters drawn as arrows, and "Rodinosyonni" is written at the bottom. Oak leaves and flowers were attached to the outer rim of the shield.
