Cassada, James	Paris, 86 yrs, 2 <sup>nd</sup> Regt., served under Capt. McCoy, fought at Lundy's Lane, Queenston Heights and Niagara.
Chambers, John	Oakland
File, Malachi	Cainsville, 84 yrs, was a sergeant in Capt. Westbrook's company and served at the Battle of Lundy's Lane
Fraser, Old (Joseph)	Tuscarora, 85 yrs, fought at Queenston, Niagara, Fort Erie, Cross Roads, Beaver Dams, Black Rock and Lundy's Lane. Was wounded in the head with a musket ball.
Freeland, Daniel A.	Scotland, 80 yrs, served off and on from 1812 to close under Capt. A. Nelles, Col. Butler and Col. Bradt. Was at Niagara, Fort Erie and in the Reserve at Lundy's Lane.
Givens, James	Tuscarora, 76 yrs, fought at Queenston, Lewiston, Black Rock, Lundy's Lane and Niagara when col. Murry took the Fort
Johnson, John Smoke	Tuscarora, 85 yrs, 3 years, fought at Lewiston, Queenston, Cross Roads, Niagara, Chippawa, Lundy's Lane, Fort Erie, Beaver Dams, Stoney Creek and the Grand River.
Johnson, William	Tuscarora, fought at all the battles his father, John Smoke Johnson, fought at.
Landon, Stephen	Mount Vernon, 78 yrs, served in the 1 <sup>st</sup> Oxford in Capt White and Lieut. Yeigh's Company. He fought at the battle of Malcolm's Mills.
Lester, Henry	Harley, 83 yrs, in 1 <sup>st</sup> Oxford Regt. As Quarter Master Sergeant. He served from the beginning to the end of war, was at Lundy's Lane and Malcolm's Mills.
Lowery, Ephraim	Brantford, 80 yrs.
McAllister, Robert P.	Mohawk (Mount Pleasant), 79 yrs, served in 1 <sup>st</sup> Oxford under Capt. White at Lundy's Lane, was on guard all night at Malcolm's Mills when 16 yrs. of age.
Oles, John	Langford, present at the Battle of Brant's Ford, Nov. 1814.
Perley, Charles Strange	Burford, 79 yrs, served under Capts. Mitchel and John Bostwick in Norfolk and Capt. Smith of Gore District. In small battle on Niagara opposite Squaw Island

Petrie, John	Oakland, 84 yrs, served in 1 <sup>st</sup> Lincoln under Major R. Hatt and
