The Order of Service

(The Congregation shall stand during the Processional and the Recessional and for all parts of the Service except the reading of the Epistle, the Announcements, the Sermon and the Offering.)

THE PROCESSIONAL HYMN

- O worship the King, all glorious above, O gratefully sing his wonderful love; Our shield and defender, the Ancient of Days.
 - Pavilioned in splendor, and girded with praise.
- O tell of his might, O sing of his grace, Whose robe is the light, whose canopy space;
 - His chariots of wrath the deep thunderclouds form,
 - And dark is his path on the wings of the storm.
- 3. The earth with its store of wonders untold.
 - Almighty, thy power hath founded of old:
 - Hath stablished it fast by a changeless decree,
 - And round it hath cast, like a mantle, the sea.

- 4. Thy bountiful care what tongue can recite?
 - It breathes in the air, it shines in the light:
 - It streams from the hills, it descends to the plain,
 - And sweetly distils in the dew and the rain.
- 5. Frail children of dust, and feeble as frail.
 - In thee do we trust, nor find thee to fail;
 - Thy mercies how tender, how firm to the end,
 - Our Maker, Defender, Redeemer, and Friend.

Response: And thou forgavest the iniquity of my sin.

Almighty God, our Maker and Redeemer, we poor sinners confess unto Thee, that we are by nature sinful and unclean, and that we have sinned against thee by thought, word and deed. Wherefore we flee for refuge to thine infinite mercy, seeking and imploring thy grace, for the sake of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Response: O most merciful God, who hast given thine only-begotten Son to die for us, have mercy upon us, and for his sake grant us remission of all our sins: and by thy Holy Spirit increase in us true knowledge of thee and of thy will and true obedience to thy Word, that by thy grace we may come to everlasting life; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

THE DECLARATION OF GRACE: Almighty God, our heavenly Father, hath had mercy upon us, and hath given his only Son to die for us, and for his sake forgiveth us all our sins. To them that believe on his Name, he giveth power to become the sons of God, and bestoweth upon them his Holy Spirit. He that believeth, and is baptized, shall be saved. Grant this, O Lord, unto us all.

Response: Amen.

THE INTROIT: Let every thing that hath breath praise the Lord: praise ye the Lord. Praise him for his mighty acts: praise him according to his excellent greatness. Praise ye the Lord. Praise God in his sanctuary: praise him in the firmament of his power.
