INSTALLATION OF THE CHANCELLOR

The Vice-Chancellor and President, Dr. Frank C. Peters, will preside until the Chancellor is installed in office.

The Chairman of the Board of Governors, Mr. William H. Timmis, will announce the election and administer the oath of office.

"Will the Chancellor-elect please rise."

"Ladies and Gentlemen, I have great pleasure in presenting the Honourable John Black Aird, Queen's Counsel, Doctor of Laws, Officer of the Order of Canada, who has been duly elected by the Board of Governors as Chancellor of this University."

"Do you therefore, John Black Aird, assume the function and office of Chancellor of this University and do you pledge yourself to keep and preserve well and faithfully, during your period of office, the statutes, liberties, customs, rights and privileges of the University, and to promote its well being and that of its members so far as in you lies."

The Chancellor-elect will reply:

"I, John Black Aird, undertake in the strength which God shall give me to perform to the best of my ability the duty of Chancellor of Wilfrid Laurier University; and I promise, as the highest academic officer of this University, to defend its rights and promote its welfare."

The Chairman of the Senate and Vice-Chancellor, Dr. Frank C. Peters, will install the Chancellor-elect in the office of Chancellor.

"As Chairman of the Senate and as Vice-Chancellor of the University, I now install you, John Black Aird, in the office of Chancellor, and by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Senate and the Board of Governors, charge you with the responsibilities which appertain to that high office."

"I now request the Vice-Chairman of the Senate to robe you in the official gown and cap of the Chancellor of Wilfrid Laurier University."

The Vice-Chairman of the Senate, Dr. Neale H. Tayler, assisted by the Secretary of the Senate, Mr. James W. T. Wilgar, and the Vice-Chairman of the Board, Mr. Robert McIntosh, will robe the Chancellor.

The Bedel, Prof. Glenn E. Carroll, will present the Mace of the University to the Chancellor.

"Mr. Chancellor, I hereby present to you the Mace of Wilfrid Laurier University and ask that you accept it as a symbol of your authority."

The Chancellor will accept the Mace.

"I accept the Mace and ask that you place it in position before me to signify the commencement of Convocation."

After the Mace has been placed in position the Chancellor will declare the Convocation to be in session.

INAUGURAL ADDRESS

The President and Vice-Chancellor, Dr. Frank C. Peters, will ask the Chancellor to address the Convocation.

CONFERRING OF DEGREES IN COURSE

The Dean of Arts & Science, Dr. Gerald R. Vallillee, will present to the Chancellor candidates for degrees. The Vice-Chancellor, Dr. Frank C. Peters, and the Vice-President: Academic, Dr. Neale H. Tayler, will assist the Chancellor in admitting undergraduates to degrees in course.

Public Orators: Announcing candidates for postgraduate degrees will be Dr. Norman E. Wagner, Dean of the Faculty of Graduate Studies, and Dr. Francis J. Turner, Dean of the Faculty of Social Work. Announcing candidates for undergraduate degrees will be Dr. Gerald R. Vallillee, Dean of the Faculty of Arts and Science, Dr. Max D. Stewart, Dean of the School of Business and Economics and Dr. Christine Mather, Dean of the Faculty of Music. Professors Grace Anderson, David Granskou, Kaye Hayashida, Harry Loewen, Josephine Naidoo and Pat Yantha will invest the candidates with academic hoods.
