Other representatives of the federal and provincial governments of Quebec and Ontario who are taking part in the "Confederation for Tomorrow" forum are the honorable Hugh Faulkner, Minister of State for Science and Technology; Dr. Stuart Smith, MPP and leader of the Ontario Liberal Party; and Dr. Victor Goldbloom, former Quebec Minister of Municipal Affairs.
