Winners of the WLU high school stock market  
games receive awards at a dinner this week

Winners of the Wilfrid Laurier University high school stock market games received awards, prizes and trophies at a dinner at WLU this week.

For the second consecutive year Port Credit Secondary School produced the provincial winner of the winter high school stock market game which began in January. The team turned a mythical \$100,000 into \$286,849 in less than three months.

The provincial winner of the fall game, which began in September, was a team from Ridgemont High School in Ottawa. The team turned its mythical \$100,000 into \$264,699.

The games, which began in a small way in 1972, now involves the largest number of high school students in Ontario in a learning experience conducted by a university. About 6,000 students from 190 high schools from across Ontario took part in the games during the past year.

During the trading period, students acted as investing groups. They bought and sold shares listed in the Toronto Stock Exchange and a university computer kept a record of their efforts. A regular broker's commission was deducted and regular reports were sent.

Prizes for the winning teams for the first game were awarded by Bell Canada and prizes for the second game were awarded by the Toronto Stock Exchange. The guest speaker at the dinner was Gerhard Wetzel, manager of education and public relations, Toronto Stock Exchange.
