WLU will offer 23 university  
courses in Brampton this fall

Brampton area residents have an opportunity to take Wilfrid Laurier University credit courses at Central Peel Secondary School this fall.

Since 1965 WLU has offered area residents, who are unable to travel to the major centers, an opportunity to work toward a university degree on a part-time basis.

In the fall and winter, 1977-78 term, WLU is offering 23 part-time courses in Brampton.

One course being offered on Saturday mornings is Literature of the Twentieth Century. Dr. Paul Tiessen, the course instructor, said the course will "examine the major literary trends in the twentieth century by looking at the work of a number of novelists and poets."

Other courses being given include anthropology, communication, geography, history, political science, philosophy, and sociology.
