Presentation of diplomas

Diplomas were awarded here Wednesday (Oct. 19) to a group of bankers from Kitchener, Waterloo and district who recently completed requirements in the Fellow's program offered by the Institute of Canadian Bankers in cooperation with Wilfrid Laurier University.

The presentation took place at Bingeman Park.

The university offers credit courses that lead to the FICB (Fellow of the Institute of Canadian Bankers) designation. The courses provide bankers with the professional management skills needed to meet the needs of their customers in these rapidly changing times.

Completion of 10 credit courses are needed for the FICB designation but diplomas are also awarded as students complete stages toward this target.

More than 5,000 bankers in Ontario are enrolled in the program at designated universities across the province.
