3 practical seminars planned  
for Toronto by Laurier university

Three seminars for a variety of management personnel in three different areas will be offered in Toronto in November by Waterloo's Wilfrid Laurier University (WLU).

Each two-day seminar is planned to cover a great deal of material in a practical, helpful way, said Kerina Elliott, director of the WLU management seminar series.

She said all seminars will be held at the Chelsea Inn on Gerrard St., Toronto, since experience has shown that those attending come from across the province and beyond. Toronto is easy to reach for most participants.

The seminars, at \$450 each, for this fall are:

The Job of the Maintenance Planner: planning, scheduling and control systems, Nov. 3-4.

How to Improve Warehouse Productivity: tested techniques for reducing costs and increasing profits, Nov. 13-14.

How to Construct and Implement a Master Production Schedule that Really Works, Nov. 20-21.

Mrs. Elliott said the university seeks top instructors from across the continent for its seminars. A similar series offered in the spring were successful, leading WLU to offer a new series.
