Missionary in Chile speaker
for Seminary auxiliary meeting

Sister Margaret Kreller, a Lutheran missionary recently returned from strife-torn Chile, will describe life on the mission field in a talk to members of the Women's Auxiliary of Waterloo Lutheran Seminary Sept. 24.

The auxiliary, with members from across Canada, will meet at St. John's Lutheran Church, Waterloo, for its annual meeting, beginning at 10 a.m.

Sister Kreller is the major speaker of the day. She graduated with her bachelor of arts degree in 1963 from Waterloo Lutheran University, the forerunner of Wilfrid Laurier University. The seminary is the federated theological college of the university.

Mrs. Clarence Heer, president of the auxiliary, will preside for the all-day session. New officers will be elected.

The auxiliary dates from the early days of the seminary and was formed to provide support of various kinds for the seminary and its students.
