Laurier fine arts lecturer
to have print show in Japan

Deirdre Chisholm, lecturer in fine arts at Wilfrid Laurier University, will have a show of her own prints and drawings this year at a prestigious art gallery in Japan.

She has been invited to show her work by the Gallery Marrison in Kyoto, a large city in central Japan. The exhibition will be held May 10 to 17, 1983. She will show about 25 of her works.

The invitation was extended during Chisholm's visit to Japan last year. It is considered a special honor to be asked to display works in Japan, since it has a great reputation for such work by its own artists.

After graduating in 1976 from the Ontario College of Art with a major in print-making and drawing, Chisholm lectured at the University of Waterloo before moving to Laurier three years ago. A show of work by her students was held recently at the Concourse Gallery at the university.
