Career fair will give directions
for students of Laurier Sept. 27

The many career possibilities open to university graduates will be displayed when 51 companies, social service agencies and government take part in Wilfrid Laurier University's fourth annual career fair Sept. 27.

Students from all programs, from first-year students to those in graduate programs, are invited to visit the booths and discuss career possibilities with the various representatives on hand for the day. The fair opens at 10 a.m. and will run through to 4 p.m.

A career fair guidebook, prepared by Laurier's placement and career services department, will be handed out to students attending the fair.

Jan Basso, manager of the department, said the fair is intended to give students an opportunity to assess the multitude of goals and choices open to them.
