Golden Hawks prepare
for Shinerama Bowl

Wilfrid Laurier University Head Coach Rich Newbrough expects over 90 prospects to turn out for the WLU football team this week. First year players, along with quarterbacks and receivers, will report Aug. 25 and upperclassmen will commence practices Aug. 27.

The Hawks will practice three times daily as they prepare for an exhibition game with the Guelph Gryphons Sept. 8. This game, in support of Cystic Fibrosis, is the first ever "SHINERAMA BOWL".

WLU's first year students will be on the streets throughout the region shining shoes and urging the public to support the fund raising day. A goal of \$15,000. has been set which is almost double the amount raised last year.

The football game will be played at Seagram's Stadium and will start at 7 p.m. All proceeds will go to the Shinerama fund.

Newbrough has a solid nucleus of returnees from the 1983 squad which finished with a 6-1 record in league play. The '83 Hawks lost in the opening round of the play-offs to McMaster, the same team they face in the league opener Sept. 15. Newbrough will be assisted by Gary Jeffries, Tom Arnott, Brad Hall, Dave Rose, Ed Dietrich, and Harry Doering.
