### RULES OF MEET

1. Any student under 20 years of age May 4th, 1946, in regular attendance at a school invited to this meet may participate.
2. Classification is not according to age of pupils but according to type of school. (Collegiates in one class; High and Continuation Schools in the other.)
3. No contestant may participate in more than three (3) events, relays excepted.
4. No substitutes from other schools will be allowed in relays.
5. The sponsors of this meet take no responsibility for injuries sustained or personal equipment lost or damaged.
6. The meet will proceed regardless of weather conditions.
7. The Official Rules of the A.A.U. of C. will be used.
8. An entry fee of Ten Cents per competitor is required.  
(One member of each delegation is asked to collect fees and pay registrar at meet.)
9. SEND ALL ENTRY FORMS TO DORIS SMITH, SEC'Y., INVITATION GAMES, WATERLOO COLLEGE, WATERLOO, BEFORE APRIL 15th, 1946.

### AWARDS

1. Goudie Trophy for Collegiate Institute winning largest number of points in meet, both boys' and girls' points counting towards the trophy in that division.
2. Hainsworth Trophy for High School or Continuation School winning largest number of points in meet, same conditions applying as in (1) above.
3. Miniature Trophies, specially designed for this meet, for winners in each event.
4. Ribbons for second and third place winners.
5. Banners for school relay winners. (All Collegiates, High and Continuation Schools may compete in the open relays for points and awards.)
6. Point scoring system will be first place 5 points, second 3 points, and third place 1 point.
