HISTORY AND AIM

WATERLOO COLLEGE SCHOOL was founded in 1914 under the name **WATERLOO COLLEGE**. With the organization of the **WATERLOO COLLEGE OF ARTS** in 1925 the name was changed to **WATERLOO COLLEGE SCHOOL**. It is the High School Department of the **LUTHERAN SEMINARY OF CANADA**.

WATERLOO COLLEGE SCHOOL is designed to be a Christian school of learning. It aims to surround the student with Christian influences; to guide him sympathetically in the pursuit of knowledge and keep before him Christian ideals; to commend the knowledge of God and Christ-like character as the highest possible attainments. To the courses of study taught in the High School and Collegiates of Ontario are added courses in religious knowledge for all Forms and all students must attend divine worship in the chapel morning and evening. A Missionary Society also provides additional opportunities for practical training in Christian service. The courses of study are so arranged that students may secure Lower School graduation in two years and Junior Matriculation at the end of the third year.

ADMISSION

High School Entrance standing or its equivalent will admit a student to the **SCHOOL** but no student will be allowed to remain after it becomes evident that he is out of harmony with the spirit of the **SCHOOL**. An earnest effort to live a Christian life is expected of all students.

PHYSICS: The course prescribed for Junior Matriculation.

CHEMISTRY: The course prescribed for Junior Matriculation.

ALGEBRA: The course prescribed for Junior Matriculation.

GEOMETRY: The course prescribed for Junior Matriculation with numerous supplementary exercises.

RELIGION: A course in Bible Teaching obligatory on all students. All students shall attend chapel services and lead Christian lives.

PHYSICAL CULTURE: Course recommended by the Department of Education for Ontario.

Note 1: All students shall attend Physical Training classes.

Note 2: All students shall attend the Laury Literary Society.

Note 3: All students studying German shall attend the German Literary Society.

JUNIOR MATRICULATION IN THREE YEARS

Waterloo College School gives every student who enters with High School Entrance standing the opportunity of obtaining Junior Matriculation standing at the end of three years. To achieve this result, however, close application is required.
