WLU to host second annual

Texaco Cup soccer tourney Feb. 1-3

Wilfrid Laurier University will host the second annual Texaco Cup indoor soccer tournament on Feb. 1, 2 & 3.

In addition to the Laurier Golden Hawks, who defeated the University of Toronto 7-1 to win the inaugural tournament last year, there will be nine other teams including the University of Waterloo Warriors, Kitchener City, the University of Windsor Lancers, the University of Western Ontario Mustangs, the York University Yeomen and the Queen's University Golden Gaels. The Canadian Youth team under head coach Tony Taylor and the U.S. entries of the University of Rochester and Eastern Michigan University round out the tournament.

Play begins on the Friday evening in the WLU gymnasium with teams playing in two five-team divisions. Games will continue all day Saturday and the top two teams in each division will play off on the Sunday morning for a berth in the final at 3:00 p.m. Sunday afternoon.

The Texaco Cup tournament, although only in its second year, has quickly become one of the most prestigious tournaments in Ontario. Barry Lyon, coach of the Laurier Golden Hawks and organizer of the tournament, was full of praise for Texaco Canada. "Without their sponsorship tournaments like this would not be possible."

The winning team and all-star team will each receive Texaco Cup track-suits and the M.V.P. of every game will receive an athletic bag. Lyon is hoping for a good turnout for all games. Last year over 2,500 people watched the tournament with 1,200 at the championship game.
