Wilfrid Laurier University statement regarding on-campus discourse re: Israeli-Palestinian conflict

WATERLOO – Wilfrid Laurier University supports the widely-held view that academic freedom, including the unfettered dissemination of knowledge and exchange of ideas, is an integral part of the university mandate. We therefore support open discussion, respectful debate and civil discourse. We are also committed to providing our students with a safe environment.
