WATERLOO – Kirby Schlegel, founder and chairman of Schlegel Sports, will visit Wilfrid Laurier University's Waterloo campus Nov. 29 to discuss entrepreneurship and lifelong habits for success in his talk, "Entrepreneurship...reinventing yourself in changing times."

Schlegel is a diversified sports and entertainment entrepreneur who has achieved success leading several professional sports teams to championships. He has owned various teams including:

- Tacoma Rainiers, Pacific Coast League
- Texas Tornado, North American Hockey League
