

Basketball Outlook For '67-'68 Season

The Waterloo Lutheran University Golden Hawks basketball team will be looking for its fifth straight basketball championship in the Ontario Intercollegiate Athletic Association conference this season.

For the past four seasons the Hawks have dominated the O.I.A.A. conference winning the league title four years in a row. Over the past four seasons in winning the league titles the Hawks have lost only one league game of the forty-nine they have played.

The only league upset for the Hawks in the four seasons was a 81-70 loss to Laurentian Voyageurs in Sudbury last season. The Hawks had beaten the Voyageurs 101-61 in a game played in Waterloo.

After losing their first two non-conference games this season to Pikeville College from Kentucky and the University of Windsor Lancers, Canada's top college basketball team last year, the Hawks recorded their first win of the 1967-1968 O.I.A.A. conference with a 88-65 win over York.

The Hawks should again dominate the O.I.A.A. conference and should go on to represent the O.I.A.A. at the Canadian nationals in March. Last year the Hawks played in the Second Century Basketball tourney in Calgary, Alta.

The Hawks under head coach Howard Lockhart have a fine starting lineup consisting of guards Sandy Nixon and Pete Misikowetz, both from London and Bob Bain from Niagara Falls. Playing the post positions with the Hawks will be 6'6" Norm Cuttiford and 6'5" Dave Baird, both from Toronto.







Hawks Profiles

SANDY NIXON

A sophomore guard at Waterloo Lutheran, Sandy is one of the smaller players on the Golden Hawks standing 6'0" and weighing 155 lbs. Sandy played his high school ball at London Central. In his last year of junior basketball in London Sandy scored 54 points in one game. While playing basketball in London he was a member of the team that won the city championship, the W.O.S.S.A. title and represented W.O.S.S.A. at the All-Ontario finals. Sandy is a fine ballhandler and his agility enables him to respond very quickly in

defensive moves.

NORM CUTTIFORD

Another representative from the London Secondary School system is 6'6", 210 lb. Norm Cuttiford. Playing post position in his final year at WLU Norm has played a lot of basketball and his experience is a valuable asset to the team.

While attending London Clarke Road Collegiate he was all-star centre in the city for two years as the Trogans won the city, W.O.S.S.A. championships. In 1962 he was a member of the Clarke Road team that played in the All-Ontario final.

Last year at WLU Norm was the team's leading scorer and top rebounder. He also played with the Kitchener Coronets two years ago when they won the Senior B Canadian championship.

PETE MISIKOWETZ

Another player from London Clarke Road, Pete is one of WLU's leading scorers. Norm and Pete were teamates at London Clarke Road and played on the same championship teams.

Pete is a fine outside shooter and is very capable of moving the ball around the court in setting up play patterns. Pete is very quick and makes many fine defensive moves destroying potential scoring opportunities by the Hawk opponents.

Pete has set two records at WLU in the three years he has been here. Two years ago he set a school record for total points in one game and a record for foul shots. In a game against the University of Windsor Pete scored 37 points in the game and scored 27 of 30 foul shots to tie the North American record. Against Pikeville College this year Pete scored 41 points to break his previously set high scoring record.


