In his remarks he spoke of one thing which he hopes and peads for and that is " a united hutheredn Church of Canada". He also referred to the anelsage of De Hillison to the meeting of Synod in which he said that fee Mutherans have nothing to hide, nothing to be ashamed of. The are opposed to that extreme attitude that is often taken by ceretain readical minds. the Dominion of Canada within the next ten years or be is bound to extend - particularly to increase in population. It is of therefore up to us to see that all hutherans who come into

our dominion be gathered into the fold. In order to inculcate into the minds of these new citigens real loyalty to low dominion it would be well to have our ministeres who have charge over them, educated in the schools of Canada and not elsewhere. Bays bountand educated in Canada sense the full meaning of the setuation, the educating of own youth in Canada Mes Aumergard of Unionville spoke to the meeting for a few minutes. She said she felt that thateiloo College Seminary was a monument to our hutheran Church.
