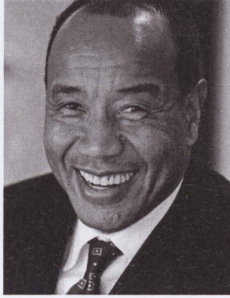




CHANCELLOR'S INSTALLATION DINNER
