### Eileen Mercier '83



Eileen Mercier is among the first women in Canada to build a career in corporate governance.

She was one of Canada's earliest female professional directors and was named a Fellow of the Institute of Corporate Directors in 2009. She has served on the boards of 28 organizations in Canada and the United States, ranging from small companies to global conglomerates. She is also a Fellow of the Institute of Canadian Bankers.

As President of Finvoy Management Inc., a management consulting firm that she founded in 1995, she specialized in financial strategy, restructuring, and corporate governance issues. She was also the former senior vice-president and chief financial officer of Abitibi-Price Inc.

Ms. Mercier continues to hold several key positions. Since 2005 she has been a director and since 2007 she has been chair of the Ontario Teachers' Pension Plan Board, which has more than \$129 billion in assets. She serves as a trustee of The University Health Network, and is a director and audit committee chair of both Intact Financial Corporation and Teekay Shipping Corporation.

An outstanding student, Eileen Mercier graduated from our university in 1968 with an Honours BA in English for which she earned a gold medal; she also won the Student Activity Award that year. During her time as a student she participated in the Students' Union, was Homecoming Chair in 1966 and sang in the university choir. She went on to sing in the chorus of a number of professional operas, and continues to be active with Laurier's Alumni Choir.

Ms. Mercier's dedication to her alma mater did not end at graduation. She served on Laurier's Board of Governors in the 1980s and was board chair from 1988 through 1990. She was chosen as Laurier's Alumna of the Year in 1990, and received the Laurier Outstanding Business Leader Award

in 1991. During Laurier's centennial year in 2011 Ms. Mercier was named one of Laurier's 100 Alumni of Achievement and that same year Women of Influence Magazine named her one of Canada's Top 25 Women of Influence. In 2012, she was designated one of Canada's 100 Most Powerful Women.

Ms. Mercier also holds an MA in English from the University of Alberta. Her studies there included philology and a course in Old Norse. An odd twist of fate saw that master's degree lead to a job writing for the Toronto Stock Exchange before she joined the Toronto-Dominion Bank and entered the business world. Ms. Mercier earned an MBA from York University in 1977, served on that university's Board of Governors for twelve years, and still serves on the Schulich School of Business advisory council at York. She was awarded an honorary doctor of laws degree from that institution in 2010.

Eileen Mercier has an exemplary record of volunteerism and philanthropy. She is a generous supporter of numerous scholarships at Laurier, including the Eileen Mercier Arts, the Eileen Mercier Science, the Hamish Mercier, and the Alumni Choir scholarships. At York University she established the Ernest C. Mercier Lecture Series in entrepreneurial chemistry in honour of her late husband.

In a recent *Globe and Mail* article Ms Mercier credits her late father, an RCMP officer, and her late mother, a nurse, with modeling courage and resilience. The fruit has indeed not fallen far from the tree. Eileen Mercier's own life has unreservedly been one of leadership and purpose.

#### Vincent Lam



It is with great delight that today we recognize Dr. Vincent Lam with an Honorary Doctor of Letters.

Dr. Lam is an author, a physician and a father. He was born in London, Ontario and raised in Nepean, Ontario in a family from the expatriate Chinese community of Vietnam. Dr. Lam earned his Bachelor of Science in Biology and his Doctor of Medicine (MD) from the University of Toronto. Early in his career, he practiced international air evacuation and expedition medicine on Arctic and Antarctic ships. He currently works as an emergency room physician at Toronto East General Hospital and lectures in the Department of Family and Community Medicine at the University of Toronto.

While maintaining his successful medical career, Dr. Lam has established himself as an exceptional Canadian author in a remarkably short period of time. He won the Scotiabank Giller Prize for his first book, a collection of short stories entitled Bloodletting & Miraculous Cures, becoming the youngest writer and only first-time author to win the Giller. The stories in Bloodletting & Miraculous Cures are based on Dr. Lam's experiences in medical school, residency and practice. His stories illuminate the anxiety of final exams, the challenges of relationships, the pursuit of self-knowledge, and the hopes that we attach to our educational achievements. In a memorable passage in the story "How to Get into Medical School, Part II," one of the main characters awaits his acceptance to medical school: "Everything would fall into place once he was accepted to the University of Toronto. That was it, the end point after which career, perfect words, heroic acts, and true love would come naturally as a matter of course."

Most recently, Lam has published his first novel, *The Headmaster's Wager*, which was short-listed for the 2012 Governor General's Literary Award and published to wide acclaim. The story is of a Chinese gambler and headmaster of an English school in Saigon during the Vietnam War was inspired by the life of his grandfather and took nearly 10 years to complete. *The Headmaster's Wager* has been praised as "epic in scope but drawn in miniature", and as "the street-level view of a story we're more accustomed to viewing in panorama."

Dr. Lam is also co-author (with public health physician Colin Lee) of *The Flu Pandemic and You*, a non-fiction guide to influenza pandemics that won the Special Recognition Award of the American Medical Writers Association in 2007. He also wrote *Tommy Douglas*, a biography of Canada's "Father of Medicare" for Penguin's Extraordinary Canadians series.

Dr. Lam's literary works deal with both his medical experience and his Asian heritage. His dual life as a writer and physician enables a fresh and illuminating perspective at the intersection of medicine and the arts. By bridging the gap between medical practice and literature, and by actively engaging with his Asian heritage through his writing, Dr. Lam embodies Laurier's commitment to developing the whole person, diversity and inclusivity, and inspiring lives of leadership and purpose.

#### FALL CONVOCATION 2013

### The Ceremony

Convocation is the most solemn ceremony within the university community. Since their beginnings in the Middle Ages, universities have performed this ceremony in order to grant degrees to their students and also to welcome those students into the community of scholars which has trained them.

The conferring of the degree is symbolized either by an acknowledgement or handshake from the Chancellor or the President or other conferring officers of the university.

As an outward sign of his or her new state, the student wears a hood. Each degree within a university has a hood of unique colours and trim in order that the student's status may be recognized—indeed every university guards its own set of hoods from use by any other university.

In order to recognize the nature of this event for the students involved, the university asks that parents and friends of the students participating in this ceremony withhold their applause until all members being admitted to each degree have left the dais. Students are asked to remain in their seats while other graduates receive their degrees.

### The Academic Degrees

The academic degree is a title conferred on an individual by a university as recognition of the completion of a course of study or for a certain attainment. In Canada, the three stages in higher education are represented by the degrees of bachelor, master and doctor. Wilfrid Laurier University is given the authority to grant degrees by the Wilfrid Laurier University Act.

The bachelor's degree is awarded at the honours and general level. An honours degree program emphasizes the acquisition of a broad and deep knowledge of the student's chosen honours subject, including both skill at applying the subject and appreciation of its relation to general knowledge and society. A general degree program emphasizes a balance between an in-depth understanding of the student's major subject and a knowledge and appreciation of other fields. Completion of an honours degree normally takes four years and a general degree, three years.

The master's degree is the second degree in higher education. Students complete concentrated and specialized work at a more advanced level in an academic discipline or professional area. Most course work is within the field of specialization and a research project or thesis is normally required. Some master's degrees provide professional qualifications. The master's degree usually requires one or two years of study after a bachelor's degree.

The doctoral degree is the highest academic degree granted by a university. Candidates for the degree spend several years in the advanced study of a specialized field of knowledge. The capstone of the degree is the doctoral dissertation, an extended work based upon independent research. The dissertation demonstrates the candidate's command of both the subject matter and the exacting methods of scholarship, and makes an original contribution to knowledge.

### Honorary Degrees

Honorary degrees are conferred by Wilfrid Laurier University in recognition of outstanding scholarly, creative, or professional achievement or distinguished public and community service. The university may grant the following honorary degrees: Doctor of Laws (LLD), Doctor of Letters (DLitt), Doctor of Science (DSc) and Doctor of Divinity (DDiv).

### Wilfrid Laurier University Mace

The mace of Wilfrid Laurier University was officially presented by the Euler family at the 1963 fall convocation in memory of The Honourable W.D. Euler, former senator of Canada and the first chancellor of the university. It weighs 16 pounds and was manufactured by the firm of Henry Birks Limited, Montreal.

The ferrule near the base of the shaft contains ivory from a walrus tusk obtained from Coral Harbour, Northwest Territories. The ten-sided shaft, representing the ten provinces, merges into the head of the mace which bears the ten provincial crests. The wood used at the point where the shaft meets the head of the mace is elm taken from the bannister post of Conrad Hall, the original seminary building. Above this are four crests relating to the history of the institution: a crest of Waterloo County, the Luther Coat of Arms, the crest of the Waterloo Lutheran Seminary and the coat of arms of the University of Western Ontario.

The head of the mace is made of maple and bears the Federal Coat of Arms, above which is the monogram of Queen Elizabeth II, during whose reign the university's charter was granted. On the reverse side is the crest of Wilfrid Laurier University and the monogram of King George V, during whose reign the original charter was granted. The top of the mace is a crown, mounted with jewels, symbolizing the authority of the State.

#### The Marshal's Baton

Dr. Fred Binding, a faculty member in the Department of Psychology for 32 years retired in July 2003. He had served as the university marshal for ten years. Sadly, Dr. Binding died in August 2003. In memory of his contribution to convocation ceremonies, artist Rex Lingwood was commissioned to create a marshal's baton.

In the baton, the artist incorporates a range of visual references that relate to the graduation ceremony, both directly and symbolically. In keeping with the nature of the ceremony, some of the forms are traditionally associated with ceremonial staffs, and the baton's design echoes the elaborate theatricality of the event and the flair brought to the occasion by Dr. Fred Binding. The ends may be read as abstracted figure forms wrapped in the academic gown and hood, with details in the university colours: purple and gold. These forms also read as plant buds, symbolizing the life stage of the graduates. The Greek alphabet is inset into an internal side surface in the shaft of the baton. This is a reference to the interests of Dr. Fred Binding. It also acknowledges that language is at the core of university education and that the Greek language has particular importance in western culture.

The commission of the baton was made possible with the generous support of the Department of Psychology and Wilfrid Laurier University Retirees' Association.

### Wilfrid Laurier University Alumni Association

Over 84,000 graduates of Wilfrid Laurier University and its predecessors are the members of the Wilfrid Laurier University Alumni Association (WLUAA). WLUAA, a volunteer driven, non-profit organization, is the official body representing Laurier alumni. The elected Board of Directors is representative of all academic faculties and many different decades.

WLUAA supports Wilfrid Laurier University with revenue from alumni services, such as group home, auto and life insurance, an affinity credit card and financial services. WLUAA revenues help to fund alumni programs, university projects, student groups, scholarships, homecoming and *Laurier Campus*, the alumni magazine.
