I am told he is not at home at
present. I am sorry the call is not
in your hands already. Will get it
to you just as quickly as I can.
Salary offered is \$1200. per annum
and free residence. I sincerely
hope you will accept, as does
every member of the Board.
There is a great work to be done
at the Seminary. The misunderstanding

have been to a large extent overcome
during the past year. The sermons are
supporting the institution better than
ever before. I know you will
have no trouble in getting along
with the sermon brethren.
The prospects for the seminary and
college were never so bright, providing
we can ^{get proper} teaching staff.
I hope and pray you may see
your way clear to accept
the call to the professorship.
