## Brantford opening for art inspired by 'Memorial to Laurier'

BRANTFORD – The "We Will Help Each Other to be Great and Good" research-based community art project will officially unveil a new work of art at a reception Friday, April 1. The event takes place at 32 Market St. at Laurier's Brantford campus. Doors open at 3 p.m., with remarks beginning at 4 p.m. This free event is open to all.

Revealed at the event will be a 16' x 8' metal quilt. Created in collaboration with artist Dave Hind, the work is a response to the 'Memorial to Laurier,' a document written in 1910 by the political activist and ethnographer James Teit, on behalf of the Thompson, Shuswap and Okanagan peoples of the southeastern interior, B.C.
