Laurier's Brantford campus to graduate nearly 500 students

BRANTFORD – Wilfrid Laurier University will hold its spring convocation ceremonies on the Brantford campus **June 7 and 8** at the Sanderson Centre for the Performing Arts.

As of May 31, approximately 489 Brantford students had met all program requirements and qualified to graduate. Laurier expects to confer three graduate degrees and 486 undergraduate degrees. On average, 80 per cent of Laurier graduands attend convocation ceremonies.
