# The Convocation Ceremony

Convocation is the most solemn ceremony within the university community. Since their beginnings in the Middle Ages, universities have performed this ceremony in order to grant degrees to their students and also to welcome those students into the community of scholars which has trained them.

The conferring of the degree is symbolized either by an acknowledgement or handshake from the chancellor or the president or other conferring officers of the university.

As an outward sign of his or her new state, the student wears a hood. Each degree within a university has a hood of unique colours and trim in order that the student's status may be recognized—indeed every university guards its own set of hoods from use by any other university.

# The Wilfrid Laurier University Mace

The mace of Wilfrid Laurier University was officially presented by the Euler family at the 1963 fall convocation in memory of The Honourable W.D. Euler, former senator of Canada and the first chancellor of the university. It weighs 16 pounds and was manufactured by the firm of Henry Birks Limited, Montreal.

The ferrule near the base of the shaft contains ivory from a walrus tusk obtained from Coral Harbour, Northwest Territories. The shaft, representing the 10 provinces, merges into the head of the mace which bears the provincial crests. The wood used at the point where the shaft meets the head of the mace is elm taken from the bannister post of Conrad Hall, the original seminary building. Above this are four crests relating to the history of the institution: a crest of Waterloo County, the Luther Coat of Arms, the crest of the Waterloo Lutheran Seminary and the coat of arms of the University of Western Ontario.

The head of the mace is made of maple and bears the Federal Coat of Arms, above which is the monogram of Queen Elizabeth II, during whose reign the university's charter was granted. On the reverse side is the crest of Wilfrid Laurier University and the monogram of King George V, during whose reign the original charter was granted. The top of the mace is a crown, mounted with jewels, symbolizing the authority of the State.

# The Marshal's Baton

Dr. Fred Binding, a faculty member in the Department of Psychology for 32 years retired in July 2003. He had served as the university marshal for 10 years. Sadly, Dr. Binding died in August 2003. In memory of his contribution to convocation ceremonies, artist Rex Lingwood was commissioned to create a marshal's baton.

In the baton, there's a range of visual references that relate to the graduation ceremony, both directly and symbolically. The baton's design echoes the elaborate theatricality of the ceremony and the flair brought to the occasion by Dr. Binding.

The commission of the baton was made possible with the generous support of the Department of Psychology and Wilfrid Laurier University Retirees' Association.

# Honorary Degrees and Other Awards

**Honorary degrees** are conferred by Wilfrid Laurier University in recognition of outstanding scholarly, creative, or professional achievement or distinguished public and community service. The university may grant the following honorary degrees: Doctor of Laws (LLD), Doctor of Letters (DLitt), Doctor of Science (DSc) and Doctor of Divinity (DDiv).

**The Order of Wilfrid Laurier University** honours worthy recipients who have a record of exemplary and distinguished service to the university.

**The Wilfrid Laurier University Awards for Teaching Excellence** honours faculty members who excel in teaching. Categories recognize sustained excellence in teaching, teaching innovation and early career excellence.

**The Teaching Assistant Award of Excellence** was established in 2007. The award aims to recognize the outstanding achievement of a Teaching Assistant or Instructional Assistant at Laurier.

**The Distinguished Governor Award** provides a mechanism for recognizing retiring and retired members of the Board of Governors who have given outstanding service to Laurier.

**The University Research Professor Award** recognizes and rewards a continuous record of outstanding scholarship or creativity by a full-time member of the Laurier faculty.

The Award for Service Excellence and Community Engagement for Faculty and Librarians recognizes individuals who in addition to their teaching and scholarship, provide exceptional service leadership.

# The Academic Degrees

The academic degree is a title conferred on an individual by a university as recognition of the completion of a course of study or for a certain attainment. In Canada, the three stages in higher education are represented by the degrees of bachelor, master, and doctor. Wilfrid Laurier University is given the authority to grant degrees by the Wilfrid Laurier University Act.

The bachelor's degree is awarded at the honours, without honours or general specified, and the general level. An honours degree program emphasizes the acquisition of a broad and deep knowledge of the student's chosen honours subject. The four-year BA without honours or general, is awarded to students who have met all honours course requirements and includes their specialization. A general degree program emphasizes a balance between an in-depth understanding of the student's major subject and a knowledge and appreciation of other fields.

The master's degree is the second degree in higher education. Students complete concentrated and specialized work at a more advanced level in an academic discipline or professional area. Most course work is within the field of specialization and a research project or thesis is normally required. Some master's degrees provide professional qualifications.

The doctoral degree is the highest academic degree granted by a university. Candidates for the degree spend several years in the advanced study of a specialized field of knowledge. The capstone of the degree is the doctoral dissertation, an extended work based upon independent research. The dissertation demonstrates the candidate's command of both the subject matter and the exacting methods of scholarship, and makes an original contribution to knowledge.

# Unique Ceremonial Stole for Indigenous Graduates

Indigenous graduates will receive a unique stole with symbolic meaning. One side of the stole depicts the Dish with One Spoon Treaty Wampum Belt between the Haudenosaunee and Anishnaabe. For them, the Dish with One Spoon marked the end of violent conflict in the hunting grounds surrounding the Great Lakes. The Spoon teaches us to avoid sharp instruments which can cause the spilling of blood. The belt describes that we all eat from one dish with one spoon and demonstrates the collective responsibility of the people to share equally. On the other side of the stole, the Kahswentha: Two Row Wampum Treaty Belt is a reminder of the historic relationship and mutual respect between the Haudenosaunee and early settlers. The belt has now come to represent the relationship between Indigenous and non-Indigenous people sharing the land in Canada. The Two Row Wampum depicts two parallel rows of purple beads which symbolize paths for two vessels: a canoe and a ship. The two vessels are forever parallel, pursuing parallel paths, never interfering with each other. Between the two paths of purple and three rows of white beads depicting the River of Life, symbolizing peace, respect and friendship.



# Eagle Feathers

Eagle feathers are presented to those individuals as a traditional rite of passage, who demonstrated dedication, commitment and determination throughout their learning journeys in the Indigenous Field of Study, Master of Social Work Program. Traditionally, in Indigenous cultures, Eagle Feathers were bestowed upon those who had undergone challenges in their growth, learning and healing. The Eagle is one of our sacred helpers and messenger to the Creator, and the Eagle Feather is a sacred symbol of strength, leadership and spiritual growth.

#### The Matters Before All Else

The Ohén:ton Karihwatékhwen is often publically referred to as the Haudenosaunee Thanksgiving Address, but such a simplistic translation can be problematic. A closer, more literal translation of the words Ohén:ton Karihwatékhwen would be The Leading Order of Business or The Matters Before All Else. This phrase comes directly from Haudenosaunee Oral History and refers back to our Creation Narrative.

Our history reminds us that once the Creator had finished preparing the Earth and everything was as he intended, he gathered the human beings and shared simple instructions. The first duty and responsibility of the Onkwehón:we (the Original Beings), was to always be thankful and to honour the Natural World. Whenever more than three people gathered together, we are obliged to first remind each other of everything in Creation that sustains and supports the Human Being. To the best of our ability, we are to recite the name of each Element and reiterate all the work they do on our behalf so that life on Earth may continue.

This recitation also reminds us to be humble and gentle in our actions as we mingle about on our Mother, the Earth. It reminds us of our human frailty and instability. While we are completely dependent on everything in Creation to sustain us, that same Creation would survive and flourish without us.

It is an incredible honour to be able to continue these ancient traditions on our original territories in our original languages. It speaks to the fortitude and resilience of our ancestors that we continue to share our traditional Haudenosaunee teachings with the Newcomers to our lands.

While there is a general, overall pattern to the Ohén:ton Karihwatékhwen, there is not a single correct version. It is unique to the individual who has been chosen to put those words through on our behalf. The version a speaker chooses will depend on the situation and the reason for the gathering. When we are in ceremony and, being thankful is of primary importance, a speaker may take up to an hour to complete the recitation. In other situations the length of the Address will be shortened to a simple grocery list similar to the one that is delivered in social functions such as this convocation. It could take as little as five minutes.

A general outline of the address is provided on the next page.

## Indigenous Thanksgiving continued

First, the Orator will start with a call out to those present to listen closely and set aside a moment to remember.

He/she will then turn our minds towards the Earth and remind us to be thankful to;

Onkwe'shón:'a, the many different types and kinds of people that we may continue to be peaceful as we mingle and travel about on earth

Yethinihsténha Onhwéntsya, Our Mother the Earth

Kahnekahrényon, The many different waters & Kentsyon'shon:'a, the many different types and kinds of fishes

Ohonte'shón:'a, The many different types and kinds of grasses, Ononhkwa'shón:'a, The many different types and kinds of natural growing medicines & Ohtera'shón:'a, The many different types and kinds of roots

Tyonnhéhkwen, The Life Sustaining plant life

Kahikshón:'a, The many different kinds of hanging fruits

Otsi'nonwa'shón:'a, The many different kinds of insects

Kontíryo, the Free-roaming, wild animals

Karonta'shón:'a, the many different kinds of trees

Otsi'ten'okón:'a, the many different kinds of birds

He/she will then turn our minds towards the Skyworld and remind us to be thankful to all of the life-giving forces of the sky

Yonkhihshot'okón:'a Ratiwéras, Our Grandfathers, the Thunderers

Kayé:ri Nikawerá:ke, The Four winds

Shonkwahtsi:'a Entye'kenékha Karáhkwa, Our Older Brother the Sun

Yethi'shótha Ahsontennékha Karáhkwa, Our Grandmother the Moon

Yotsihstohkwarónnyon, The Night-time Stars

Kayé:ri niyonkwè:take, The Four Beings

Shonkwaya'tíson, Our Creator

The speaker will then turn back to the people gathered and reiterate that he did the best that he was able and if anything had been missed or forgotten that the people can make it right in their minds.

Tahnon O:nen E'tho, And there that is how it shall be.

# 2017 Honorary Degree Recipients

#### CHERYL REGEHR Presented on October 27, 4:30 pm



Wilfrid Laurier University alumnus, Cheryl Regehr ('78), is one of Canada's leading scholars in social work. After completing her Masters in Social Work (University of Toronto '80), Cheryl started a career in emergency mental health services, working for over 20 years in forensic social work and the administration of mental health programs. With experience in civil litigation and criminal court assessments of trauma victims and violent offenders, Cheryl has served in leadership and advisory

capacity for organizations like the Department of National Defence, Veterans' Affairs Canada, and the Board of Trustees for the University Health Network. After completing her PhD (University of Toronto '95) Cheryl started her academic career at Laurier in the Faculty of Social Work and achieved many notable awards, like Teacher of the Year, the Amicus Award for contributions to forensic psychiatry, the Beverley Antle Award for Leadership, and the Leonard Gibbs Award for outstanding review in social work. She now serves the University of Toronto as the Vice-President and Provost (2013 – present).

## BONNIE R. BROOKS Presented on October 28, 1:00 pm



Born and raised in Windsor, Ontario, Bonnie Brooks has set the standard for high-achieving women in Canadian business. Since her earliest position as a copywriter and stylist for Fairweather (Dylex Ltd.) Bonnie's career in business and philanthropy has been motivated by the pursuit of excellence. She ascended the ranks of Canada's fashion industry, transforming luxury retailers like Holt Renfrew into "fashion destinations", and eventually relocating to Hong Kong where she became President

of the Lane Crawford Group (2003). In 2008, Bonnie was the first woman appointed as President and CEO of the Hudson's Bay Company (HBC). In that same year, she completed her MBA (University of Western Ontario, Ivey Business School). Bonnie is credited with revamping the Hudson's Bay brand, a financial turnaround, and superior leadership while the company made major acquisitions like the US department stores Lord & Taylor and Saks Fifth Avenue. In 2016, Bonnie retired as vice-chair of HBC, but continues to actively serve on boards like Rogers Communications, RioCan Real Estate Investment Trust, Chico's FAS and Abercrombie & Fitch.

# Installation of The President and Vice-Chancellor

DEBORAH L. MACLATCHY Installation Ceremony, October 27, 9:30 am



Madam Chancellor, I have the honour of presenting to you Dr. Deborah MacLatchy.

Dr. MacLatchy is a person of many talents and accomplishments — a distinguished researcher, a committed teacher, a skilled administrator, a champion of women in science, a valued colleague, and a cherished daughter, sister, aunt, spouse, and friend.

Born into a family of educators in Wolfville, Nova Scotia, Dr. MacLatchy comes by her passion for education honestly. Her father, Cyrus, a physics professor at Acadia University, and her mother,

Ann, a special education teacher, encouraged all three of their daughters to study a broad range of subjects.

As a child growing up on the shores of the Minas Basin and the nearby Bay of Fundy, Deborah soaked up the area's rich history and developed a love for water. Later, as a student at Acadia University, she was torn between science and history. Science won out eventually, but she has retained an abiding interest in history — one she nurtures as an avid reader of historical novels.

Dr. MacLatchy earned an honours B.Sc. in biology from Acadia and a PhD in zoology from the University of Manitoba. She did postdoctoral work at the University of Guelph and began her academic career at the University of Winnipeg and the University of New Brunswick.

Her research — which she has continued in addition to her administrative duties — involves ecotoxicology and comparative endocrinology, with a focus on how industrial pollutants affect endocrine pathways in fish.

Dr. MacLatchy's research accomplishments are many: she has published more than 80 peer-reviewed publications; she is funded by the Natural Sciences and Engineering Research Council of Canada and through industry and federal, provincial and territorial grants; she is a founding fellow and past-chair of the science directors of the Canadian Rivers Institute; she is a past-president and council member of the Canadian Society of Zoologists; she is co-lead of the ecotoxicology node of the Southern Ontario Water Consortium; and, in 2005, she received a prestigious NSERC Synergy Award for Innovation to recognize the success of her industrial and government partnerships to remediate the environmental effects of pulp-mill effluents.

Dr. MacLatchy's leadership record is equally impressive.

At the University of New Brunswick, she served as dean of Science, Applied Science and Engineering, and as director of the university's International Office. In 2007, she joined Laurier as dean of the Faculty of Science. In 2009, she was appointed vice-president: academic and provost. She was reappointed to this role in 2014 for a second term. In January 2017, the university's presidential search committee selected Dr. MacLatchy as its unanimous choice to be the next president and vice-chancellor of Wilfrid Laurier University.

Throughout her time at Laurier, Dr. MacLatchy has played a lead role in many initiatives. These include: the creation of a new strategic academic plan; development of the university's multi-campus governance framework; the launch of the Laurier Institute for Water Science; the creation of the Laurier Centre for Women in Science; the establishment of the Laurier Women in Science and Leadership Award; the creation and expansion of the Office of Indigenous Initiatives; championing diversity, equity, and inclusivity; and the development of the university's strategic mandate agreements with the Government of Ontario.

Over the course of her distinguished career, Dr. MacLatchy has been recognized with a number of significant awards. These include: an honorary doctorate from Acadia University in 2016; the 2015 Recognition Award from the Senior Women Academic Administrators of Canada; and, in 2012, she was named one of Canada's Most Powerful Women in a Top 100 list compiled by the Women's Executive Network.

Madam Chancellor, on behalf of the Board of Governors of this university, I ask you to install Dr. Deborah MacLatchy as the president and vice-chancellor of Wilfrid Laurier University.


