TO PROMOTE THEIR ANNUAL PURPLE AND GOLD SHOW, THIS YEAR ENTITLED
"SKITS O' FRENZY."

LAST NIGHT C.K.C.R. RECEIVED A CALL FROM THE ENGINEERING STUDENTS

OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WATERLOO WHO CLAIMED THAT THEY HAD STOLEN

THE TICKET BOOTH AND THAT THEY ARE DEMANDING A RANSOM OF A BLOCK

OF TICKETS TO THIS YEAR'S P & G SHOW.

HOWARD FROMKIN, PUBLICITY DIRECTOR OF THE P & G SHOW ISSUED THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT: "WE THE WUC STUDENTS ADMIT THAT WE HAVE BEEN HOODWINKED.
