RELEASE LATE: JANUARY 25, 1962 <u>GEOGRAPHERS TO HEAD PANEL ON RUSSIA AT WATERLOO LUTHERAN UNIVERSITY</u> IN ORDER TO PRESENT THE TRUE FACTS ABOUT RUSSIA AS IT IS TODAY, THE GEOGRAPHY CLUB OF WATERLOO UNIVERSITY COLLEGE IS HOLDING A "SYMPOSIUM ON RUSSIA".

THE OFFICIAL PANEL WILL CONSIST OF THREE EMINENT GEOGRAPHERS; DR. RUGGLES, CHAIRMAN OF THE GEOGRAPHY DEPARTMENT AT QUEENS UNIVERSITY AND FOREMOST CANADIAN AUTHORITY ON THE SOVIET FAR EAST; DR. DOHRS, HEAD OF THE GEOGRAPHY DEPARTMENT, WAYNE STATE UNIVERSITY, AND CO-AUTHOR OF "OUTSIDE READINGS IN GEOGRAPHY"; AND DR. KISH, AUTHOR OF "ECONOMIC ATLAS OF RUSSIA" AND HEAD OF THE GEOGRAPHY DEPARTMENT, UNIVERSITY OF MICHIGAN.

EACH OF THESE SPEAKERS WILL DELIVER A SHORT ADDRESS ON SOME ASPECT OF RUSSIA WHICH WILL BE ILLUSTRATED WITH ACTUAL SLIDES OF RECENT VISITS TO THAT COUNTRY. THIS WILL BE FOLLOWED BY AN EXTENSIVE PANEL DISCUSSION AND QUESTION AND ANSWER PERIOD,
