FROM WATERLOO LUTHERAN UNIVERSITY

COMPLETE PSYCHOLOGY DEPARTMENT NAMED AT WATERLOO LUTHERAN UNIVERSITY

DR. LLOYD H. SCHAUS, DEAN OF THE UNIVERSITY COLLEGE OF WATERLOO LUTHERAN UNIVERSITY, ANNOUNCED TODAY THE APPOINTMENT OF DR. MAX L. HILLMER JR. OF LA GRANGE, ILLINOIS, AS ASSISTANT PROFESSOR OF PSYCHOLOGY. EDUCATED AT WAYNE UNIVERSITY, DETROIT, MICHIGAN; NORTHWESTERN UNIVERSITY, EVANSTON, ILLINOIS; AND THE UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON, DR. HILLMER RECEIVED HIS PH.D IN 1960.

DR. HILLMER HAS WORKED AS A PSYCHOLOGIST AT THE EAST MOLINE STATE HOSPITAL, EAST MOLINE, ILLINOIS AND AT JACKSONVILLE STATE HOSPITAL, JACKSONVILLE, ILLINOIS. FROM 1955 TO 1961 DR. HILLMER SERVED ON THE FACULTY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON AS TEACHING ASSISTANT, EXTENSION INSTRUCTOR, RESEARCH ASSISTANT, AND LATTERLY AS PROJECT DIRECTOR OF THE FACULTY RESEARCH TRAINING PROGRAM AT THE UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON SCHOOL OF NURSING. IN 1962 DR. HILLMER SERVED AS ASSISTANT PROFESSOR OF PSYCHOLOGY AT THE ILLINOIS STATE NORMAL UNIVERSITY.

ALSO ANNOUNCED IS THE APPOINTMENT OF DR. CLIFFORD W. ANDERSON, MONTREAL, AS ASSISTANT PROFESSOR. DR. ANDERSON RECEIVED HIS B.ED FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF SASKATCHEWAN AND HIS M.SC IN APPLIED PSYCHOLOGY AND HIS PH.D FROM MCGILL UNIVERSITY.

DR. ANDERSON HAS BEEN WITH MCGILL UNIVERSITY SINCE 1958 AND HAS SERVED THERE AS GUIDANCE AND RESEARCH ASSISTANT, LECTURER AND VOCATIONAL GUIDANCE OFFICER, AND ASSISTANT PROFESSOR. BOTH PROFESSORS WILL COMMENCE THEIR DUTIES IN EARLY SEPTEMBER.

THE PSYCHOLOGY DEPARTMENT OF WATERLOO UNIVERSITY COLLEGE, WITH PROFESSOR DONALD F. MORGENSON AS CHAIRMAN, NOW HAS THREE FULL-TIME FACULTY MEMBERS AND TWO LECTURERS, MISS RUTH DETTMER AND MRS. JUNE PINKNEY, BOTH OF KITCHENER.
