YOUTH ENCOURAGED TO LONGER STUDY
BY WATERLOO UNIVERSITY COLLEGE GRANTS

THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM OF WATERLOO (ONTARIO) UNIVERSITY COLLEGE WAS

EXPANDED TODAY TO MOTIVATE HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS TOWARD HIGHER ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT

AND TO HELP ASSURE WORTHY STUDENTS, THROUGH FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE, IN ATTAINING

UNIVERSITY EDUCATION.

THREE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS ARE NOW OFFERED ON AN UNLIMITED AND CONTINUING BASIS: UNLIMITED AS TO THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS THAT CAN QUALIFY AND CONTINUING THROUGH THE STUDENT'S THREE OR FOUR YEARS OF UNIVERSITY WORK. THE AWARDS ARE TO BE MADE ANNUALLY BY THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON SCHOLARSHIPS OF WATERLOO LUTHERAN UNIVERSITY.

DEAN LLOYD H. SCHAUS, WHO MADE THE ANNOUNCEMENT, SAID THAT WLU HOPES
TO DO ITS SHARE THROUGH THESE SCHOLARSHIPS TO ASSURE UNIVERSITY DEGREES TO YOUNG
MEN AND WOMEN WHO HAVE HIGH ACADEMIC STANDING AND LIMITED FINANCIAL RESOURCES.
THE THREE GROUPS OF SCHOLARSHIPS ARE:

PROFICIENCY SCHOLARSHIPS: FREE TUITION AND \$50 BOOK CREDIT, A TOTAL ANNUAL VALUE OF \$475. AWARDED TO ALL STUDENTS ENTERING THE UNIVERSITY WITH AN AVERAGE OF 75% OR HIGHER IN NINE GRADE XIII PAPERS. THE SCHOLARSHIP WOULD BE CONTINUED THROUGH YEARS PROVIDING THE STUDENT MAINTAINS A 70% AVERAGE.

WLU SCHOLARSHIPS....TAKE 2

FACULTY-BOARD SCHOLARSHIPS: MAXIMUM VALUE OF \$2,500 FOR THE FOUR YEARS INCLUDING FREE TUITION AND \$200 ANNUALLY IN CASH TOWARD OTHER EXPENSES. AWARDED TO ENTERING STUDENTS WHO HAVE ACHIEVED AN AVERAGE OF 80% IN NINE GRADE XIII PAPERS. CONTINUING THROUGH FOUR YEARS PROVIDING AN AVERAGE OF 75% IS MAINTAINED.

CENTENNIAL SCHOLARSHIPS: \$1,340 A YEAR INCLUDING TUITION, ROOM, BOARD, BOOKS, AND A CASH AMOUNT OF \$300, THE LATTER TO BE USED IN SUMMER STUDY HERE OR OVERSEAS OR AS AN AID TOWARD POSTGRADUATE WORK. TO QUALIFY STUDENTS MUST HAVE ATTAINED A MINIMUM COVERAGE OF 90% IN NINE GRADE XIII PAPERS AND MUST MAINTAIN AN AVERAGE OF 85% EACH COLLEGE YEAR.
