ENDRESS APPOINTED TO CHURCH-WIDE  
PRESS-RADIO-TELEVISION COMMISSION

NEW YORK -- DR. HENRY ENDRESS, VICE-PRESIDENT OF WATERLOO LUTHERAN UNIVERSITY, HAS BEEN APPOINTED TO SERVE AS A MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION ON PRESS, RADIO AND TELEVISION OF THE LUTHERAN CHURCH IN AMERICA, IT WAS ANNOUNCED TODAY BY DR. MALVIN H. LUNDEEN, SECRETARY OF THE CHURCH. THE ACTION WAS TAKEN BY THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL OF THE LUTHERAN CHURCH IN AMERICA, THE NEWLY-MERGED CHURCH BODY WITH WHICH THE EASTERN CANADA SYNOD, WITH HEADQUARTERS IN THE TWIN CITIES, IS AFFILIATED.

ENDRESS IS THE SECOND CANADIAN RESIDENT TO SERVE ON THE COMMISSION. THE OTHER CANADIAN IS THE REV. ARTHUR CONRAD, PASTOR OF ST. PETER'S LUTHERAN CHURCH, OTTAWA.
