SELECTED FOR TRAINING IN GERMANY

SECOND LIEUTENANT TERRENCE THOMAS SCOTT, OF 11 ALCINA AVENUE, TORONTO, A SECOND YEAR ARTS STUDENT AT WATERLOO UNIVERSITY COLLEGE OF WATERLOO LUTHERAN UNIVERSITY, HAS BEEN SELECTED TO TRAIN WITH THE FIRST BATTALION OF THE QUEEN'S OWN RIFLES OF CANADA IN GERMANY IT WAS ANNOUNCED TODAY (WEDNESDAY) BY MAJOR J.M. CLARK, OFFICER COMMANDING THE WATERLOO UNIVERSITY COLLEGE DETACHMENT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WESTERN ONTARIO CONTINGENT, CANADIAN OFFICERS' TRAINING CORPS.

IT IS AN HONOUR FOR SCOTT TO BE CHOSEN, SAID MAJOR CLARK. EACH YEAR THE TOP C.O.T.C. CADETS IN CANADA ARE SELECTED TO TRAIN IN GERMANY. SECOND LIEUTENANT SCOTT WILL LEAVE CANADA IN MAY TO JOIN THE QUEEN'S OWN, NOW SERVING WITH THE FOURTH CANADIAN INFANTRY BRIGADE. HE WILL RETURN TO W.L.U. IN OCTOBER.
