WORKSHOP WILL PROBE

CAMPUS-COMMUNITY RELATIONSHIPS

Student Council members and presidents of campus organizations at Waterloo Lutheran University will get together Thursday and Friday for frank discussion of student activities on campus and in the community.

Dr. Frederick J. Speckeen, dean of students, said the discussions are aimed at helping the students to get to know one another and discuss various aspects of campus and community relationships.

The keynote address, The Role of the Student Leader, will be given Thursday afternoon by Donald Young, dean of men at Loyola College, Montreal. A discussion will follow.

At night, a panel on Student Discipline As I See It will be led by Dean Esther Brandon, WLU's associate dean of students. Taking part will be David Pady of Willowdale, Student Council president; Dean Young; Prof. Paul Dudgeon, head resident of West Hall men's residence; Sgt. Harold Bassey of the Waterloo Police Department; and Alfred Mason, Waterloo probation officer.

A discussion on the responsibility of students will highlight Friday's session. A briefing on student orientation week activities and a dinner will bring the workshop to a close.

Dr. Speckeen said the university felt the meeting could go a long way in developing good student relationships in the community. "We value our good neighbor relationship with the people of Waterloo and want to do everything in our power to see that it continues," he said.

"The workshop will provide an opportunity for university administrators, community representatives and students to consider their mutual problems and concerns."
