WLU GOLDEN HAWKS OPEN SEASON

WEDNESDAY AGAINST GUELPH

The Waterloo Lutheran University Golden Hawks open the Ontario Intercollegiate Football Conference this Wednesday evening, September 23, when they play host to the University of Guelph Redmen. Game time at Seagram Stadium is 8:00 p.m. Other clubs in the eight team league see action on Saturday.

The Hawks, who placed seven players on the 1963 all-star team and have six of them returning, are hoping for an improvement over the 5-2 record which gave them second place last year. Coach Bob Celeri has 18 members of last year's team back and is counting on some promising rookies to fill out the lineup. Lack of proven depth at some key positions could be a weakness in the Hawk armor as Celeri will be counting on some players to go both ways.

The Hawk attack is centred around last year's league rushing and scoring leader, Erhard (Ed) Turek of Hamilton, who will see action at both halfback and fullback. Sophomore Don Wilson of Hamilton is expected to start at quarterback and will alternate with senior Paul Heinbecker of Waterloo, who won all-star rating last year on defense, and rookie David Meyers of London. Returning all-stars, in addition to Turek and Heinbecker, are middle guard John Martens, a senior from Beamsville; and sophomore linemen Gord Byers of Sudbury, Paul Huston and Bob Goodman of Toronto.
