WLU LAUNCHES SECOND SERIES OF

MANAGEMENT WORKSHOP-SEMINARS

A two-day workshop-seminar on package weight control February 4-5 will open this year's series of management seminars at Waterloo Lutheran University.

Up to twenty-five business executives from Ontario and Quebec are expected to attend the workshop-seminar, organized by the department of business administration of Waterloo University College, the arts and science faculty of Waterloo Lutheran University.

Conducting the seminar will be Dr. Brant Bonner, professor of business administration and director of management seminars, and Dr. Herman Overgaard, chairman of the department.

Dr. Bonner said the seminar is designed to show how control procedures can be established in filling operations. Topics covered will include overfill, legal and mechanical aspects of package weight control.

Mr. C. S. Phillips, Chief of the Weights and Measures Division, Standards Branch, Department of Trade and Commerce, has accepted the university's invitation to be its guest throughout the seminar.

This second series of workshop-seminars on latest trends and developments in business follows the success of the first series launched last spring.

Topics covered in the first series included operations improvement, package weight control, network system and evolutionary operation.
