<u>A Taste of University Features</u> <u>WLU Parents Orientation Day</u>

Parents and friends attending Waterloo Lutheran University's fifth annual Parents Orientation Day, September 16 will have a chance to turn back the clock and attend university lectures themselves.

One of the 10 different lectures available may even help father when it comes to discussing school with his high school age children. Prof. Frank Sweet, acting chairman of the mathematics department, will discuss "What's New About the New Math?"

Another lecture dealing with recent research is psychology which will include a laboratory demonstration. The speaker will be the popular Prof. Clifford Anderson, associate professor of psychology.
