<u>Alumnus of the Year Award</u>

To Feature Homecoming Events

Rev. Ward L. Kaiser, a 1945 graduate of Waterloo Lutheran University, will be honored during the university's Homecoming Weekend on Saturday night as he becomes the university's Alumnus of the Year.

Mr. Kaiser, a former E.U.B. pastor at Kitchener, Rostock and Stratford, now is editor of Friendship Press in New York City and is a director of the commission for youth for the National Council of Churches in the United States.

During Canada's centennial year, he sponsored a series of books about Canada which were distributed for study to church organizations on both sides of the border.

The alumni dinner honoring Mr. Kaiser will be held at the Holiday Inn, Kitchener at 7 p.m., preceded by class reunions and a meeting of the honors geography society at 5 o'clock. A dance will follow.

The Homecoming Weekend begins with a concert in the WLU Theatre-Auditorium Friday at 8:30 p.m., featuring singer Malka and creative guitarist Lenny Breau. It ends with an alumni church service and coffee hour at St. Matthew's Lutheran Church on Sunday.
