Interest in Summer Education

Brings Spate of Early Applications

It looks like hundreds of teachers throughout Ontario are planning a studious summer.

Even though Waterloo Lutheran University's regular summer session for teachers and others doesn't begin until June 30, more than 900 classroom places have already been filled. By comparison, fewer than 200 had enrolled by this time a year ago.

Henry Dueck, university registrar, said there is room for about 2,400 students and he expects he will be turning many away by the time lectures begin. Already, seven classes have their full quota of students.

Waterloo Lutheran's summer session covers six weeks, with the last class on Aug. 7. It allows a student to take one or two full credit courses toward a degree. Fifteen credits are required for the Bachelor of Arts degree.

Most summer session students are Ontario public and high school teachers. Some are regular WLU students and others are adults of various backgrounds who have decided to seek further education.
