125 Course Sections To Be Offered

When WLU Summer Session Begins July 5

Growing interest in part-time education is reflected in the 125 course sections to be offered during Waterloo Lutheran University's summer session beginning July 5. Last year, course offerings totalled 112.

Already more than 1,600 mailed registrations have been received from men and women throughout the province. Henry H. Dueck, university registrar, expects more than 3,200 will have registered for the six-week session by the time classes begin.

Courses are offered at the Waterloo campus at the Orillia District Collegiate, 2 Borland St. East. Ninety-two courses will be taught at Waterloo and 33 in Orillia. All courses are for degree credit and cover the full range of subjects from biology to history and from politics to physics.

"Public and separate school teachers make up the bulk of those taking courses," Mr. Dueck said. "Requirements for primary school teaching are being upgraded and by the fall of 1973 students entering teachers college will need a degree."

Some offerings of the School of Business and Economics and the School of Religion and Culture will begin May 10. In addition, the second annual Summer Vocal Workshop will be conducted between July 19 and Aug. 13. More than 100 are expected to attend these courses.
