To Public On Sunday

Waterloo Lutheran University will hold its annual Open House this Sunday from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m., an event that attracts close to 500 people to see the university in operation.

New this year among things to see is the electronic stock market ticker tape, the only one on a Canadian university campus. It will be explained by Prof. Robert Quinn of the WLU School of Business and Economics.

Among other events is the short recital at 1:30 p.m. by music students in voice and piano, a talk by Dr. Leon Thiry of the philosophy department at 2 p.m. on some recent experiments in peace education and a talk by Dr. Lawrence Toombs at 2:30 p.m. on archaeology. His talk will be illustrated with recent research slides.

In addition, the audio-visual department will show some old-time movies and visitors will have an opportunity to "play student" in the language laboratory. Many other demonstrations will provide a full afternoon

While intended primarily as a means of introducing parents of freshmen parents to the university, Open House also provides those in the community with an opportunity to see how a university operates.
