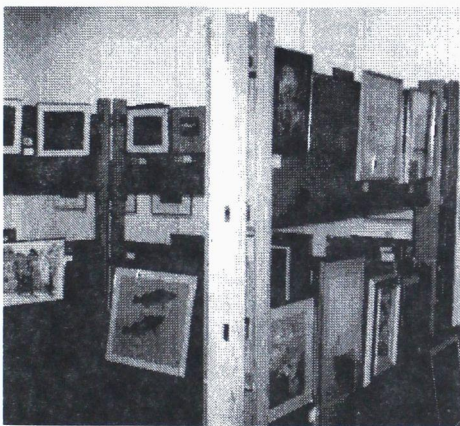


## N. V. ARTS COUNCIL PROGRAMS
