RATIONALE:

To bring the Standing Rules in line with the current and recent past practices regarding submission of paintings.

MEMBERSHIP

The Board of Directors shall have power to charge fees to members for classes, lectures, or exhibitions sponsored by the Society.

CHANGE TO:

The Board of Directors shall have power to charge fees to members for classes, lectures, web sites, or exhibitions sponsored by the Society.

RATIONALE:

To provide for the inclusion of web site fees.

NOMINATIONS, ELECTIONS OF DIRECTORS AND APPOINTMENTS

The Directors of the Society are: Education, Exhibitions, Membership, Publicity and Archives, Socials.

CHANGE TO:

The Directors of the Society are: Education, Exhibitions, Membership, Publicity and Archives, and Workshops
