Announces four new Assistance programs.

1. Professional Development Assistance program:

Up to \$1500 available for study in arts administration, creative writing, dance video, multi-disciplinary studies, museological and conservation studies, music (performance, composition), publishing studies, theatre (acting, directing, technical) and visual arts. 2. Project Assistance for Visual Artists:

This pilot program is designed to provide assistance on a project basis to professional visual artists (minimum 5 years experience) to realize creative projects. Intended to assist by providing time for creation. Deadline September 15th. For more information call: CSB Victoria 1-356-1718.

3. Performing Arts Recommendor Program: This pilot program is designed to allocate assistance to individual artists through arts organizations for the purposes of creating new works such as the commissioning of a play, an original music composition or a new choreographic work.
