Penalties

Penalties are imposed for failure to file returns on or before due dates as stated above.

Forms are available at Taxation Offices, Winch Building, Vancouver, B. C.; Post Office Building, Victoria, B. C.; Post Office Building, Nelson, B. C.; also at all Post Offices.

Bread Hints

If one wants a particularly light dough, add to the sponge a tablespoon of well mashed Irish potato. Beat into the matter of sifted flour, dissolved yeast, and if for tea rolls, eggs. Add flour till the dough is the right consistency, then knead it thoroughly, both to mix the ingredients and to put as much air as possible into it, and make it of finer grain. Set it to rise in a warm place—eighty degrees is best, in a closet or corner protected from draughts. When it has risen to double its original bulk, shape the dough into loaves or rolls. In so doing you may knead it lightly, but add no more flour or the quality will be poor. Use just barely enough flour on the board to keep it from sticking. Set the pans away for the last rising, then bake and cool on a wire rack.
