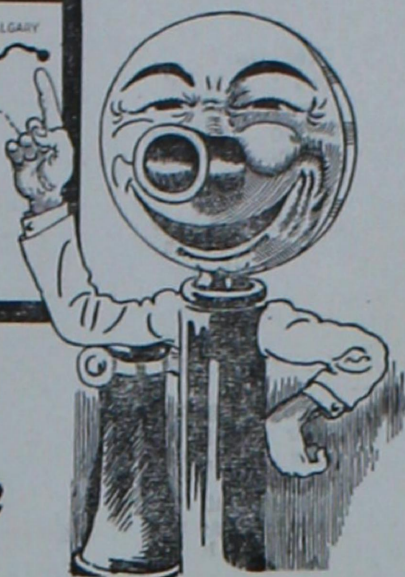


Telephone **DIRECT** to Alberta now



by the new
all-Canadian route



As a result of construction work just completed, there is now a direct telephone line across British Columbia from Vancouver to Calgary, giving for the first time an all-Canadian route from the Coast to Alberta.

Calls between Coast points and Alberta have, in the past, been routed via Seattle, there being no circuit available across British Columbia. The British Columbia Telephone Company, by extending a line from Kamloops to the Alberta boundary, a distance of 263 miles, and linking up there with a line of the Alberta telephone system, has provided a through all-Canadian circuit that will greatly increase the speed with which calls between the two provinces can be handled.

The new service is available not only to Coast points, but also to such places as Kamloops, Merritt, Princeton, Hedley, Keremeos,

Oliver, Penticton, Summerland, Kelowna, and Vernon.

Three Kinds of Service

1. STATION-TO-STATION. You call a number, but not a person, and you pay if you get the number.
2. PERSON-TO-PERSON. You call a person, and pay if you get him. Rate 25% higher than station-to-station.
3. APPOINTMENT. You place a call to be put through at a specified time. Rate 50% higher than station-to-station.

Evening and Night Rates

Evening rate, station-to-station only, 7 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.: 25% lower than day.
Night rate, station-to-station only, 8:30 p.m. to 7 a.m.: 50% lower than day.

Though thousands of salmon may be seen ascending the Capilano and other North Shore streams at present, the run is not believed to be unusual, officials of the fisheries department state.

One of the most successful chum salmon fishing seasons has just closed on the west coast of Vancouver Island, according to officials who announce that, with the exception of a small area around Nitinat, all salmon fishing is now proscribed in that district.

Conditions in the Vancouver, Howe Sound and Fraser River districts remain favorable, it is said, and closure will not be applied for several weeks yet. The Fraser River area is usually the last to close.
