



**ASTROLOGY
AS I SEE IT**

With all the magazines on the bookshelves of the market dealing with astrology, to write more upon the subject seems superfluous. One can easily buy a magazine, outlining the future for each sign of the Zodiac, at least for a year, while others will sell you, for a few dollars, a book, or enlist you on a course that will bestow upon you, divine wisdom in a relatively short time.

However, unless one has the tools given him at birth, on taking advantage of these offers through literature, he is doomed to disappointment.

However, one gets more satisfaction working on a horoscope than on a crossword puzzle. At best, one is working on the matter of something sacred - a human being.

These magazines mentioned take the whole sign and the positions of the planets, which is not quite so complete as taking in the individual horoscope, and since astrologers of old have taken the time of the new moon, as a time of starting new projects, and the full moon as the time of completion, those born for example, around the 19th of

September, down to June 11, 1972, will have a new moon on their birthdays, whilst those one or two days prior to these dates, might find the former pattern of their lives are due to be changed.

The new moon of September 19th, will be very important to those born on that date, as the sun rules the will, and the moon rules the feelings; being together, there is little difficulty making up one's mind, as those born on the day of the new moon have as a theme song, "I Want What I Want When I Want It." On this date, Saturn, the planet of restriction turns retrograde, while Jupiter (expansion) is conjunct with Neptune, the dreamer, so Virgo, the sign of the workers, will demand action with reference to economic matters.

With reference to birth at the new moon, Canada became a nation July 1, 1867, and this was the day prior to the new moon, so this may explain why Canada has little vision of her own, and must need to depend on the United States for a lead.

However, financial matters in the lives of Virgo people will be stimulated by Venus and Uranus being in their second house (money & resources), while Jupiter and Neptune will be in their third of mind, trips and messages will make them

more optimistic, and since in November greater emphasis will be placed in their 4th house of home and parents, one can expect changes in these matters, even though the square of these planets to Virgo may call for an effort on these parts.

Virgo people are routine workers, and better as second in command, rather than leaders. As an employer, he is too easy going with his employees, and as he is constantly seeking perfection, he sells his services far too cheaply. As an employee, his superior can spot him a mile away and loads on the work, while Virgo has to fight for his money.

Virgo, on the whole, is usually very psychic, especially in the early degrees of the sign, and he is very often connected with sickness and service.

However, Virgos are fortunate in the sense that they are connected with the six primary forces of nature, the sign of magic, and can usually do anything they set their minds on, and this is one reason why they make excellent research workers.
