It's been a busy year on Council and I'll be glad of the summer break. The East Ward seems to grow and grow and likewise the problems.

This year will see Dymond Drive, Fredrick Street and Stewart Street paved to an urban standard (with sidewalks, curbs and gutters). Powell Road will also be paved from Mansfield to Broadview. As a condition of change in the subdivision agreement with Whitby Town Estates I have insisted a sidewalk be built on Kendalwood from Nicol Avenue to Sawdon. This should be completed by August 31 this year; also the park at Kirby will be completed this fall. Scott Street from Rossland to Dymond will have lights upgraded this year and we are in the process of trying to put a Brewers Retail store in the K-Mart Plaza - just north of the Best for Less Store.

A Neighbourhood Watch program has been put in place in the Pringle Creek subdivision. Certainly Mr. Weeks and Mrs. Tibbo deserve a great deal of credit for their endeavors. It seems other areas of town are now looking at forming Neighbourhood Watch, and if I can be of assistance just call!
